Honorable Meenu Sasser Mentorship Award

Within the context of growth and professionalism, the importance of mentoring lawyers has been recognized by local bar associations and state bar organizations all over the country, including both the Florida Bar¹³ and the American Bar Association.² In fact, discussions among bar leaders in Florida identified that mentoring is key to the future of the practice of law and continued professionalism and civility. As a result, the Florida Bar Standing Committee on Professionalism joined with the Henry Latimer Center for Professionalism to create a "Mentoring Toolbox" to promote mentoring on a local level and assist local bar associations and committees in forming and launching mentoring programs.

Recognizing the importance and impact of mentoring, the Professionalism Committee of the Palm Beach County Bar Association recommends those interested in mentoring to contact the Florida Bar regarding their Counsel to Counsel Mentoring Program.¹

To further promote mentoring and to recognize those who exemplify professionalism through mentoring, the Palm Beach County Bar Association has created the Honorable Meenu Sasser Mentoring Award through the support of the Young Lawyers Section, to honor its member and esteemed jurist, who was well-known for mentoring lawyers and judicial colleagues.

This award is given each year posthumously honoring Judge Sasser during the luncheon of the Bench Bar Conference, currently scheduled on March 6, 2026.

Eligible Recipients: Individual members of the Palm Beach County Bar Association.

Selection Criteria: The Honorable Meenu Sasser Mentoring Award recognizes an attorney or Judge who has demonstrated or promoted mentoring in Palm Beach County. Nominations are submitted by members of the Palm Beach County Bar and/or mentees, whether formal or not, and if selected will be presented at each year's bench bar by a representative of the Young Lawyers Section.
