ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 11.106 – 05/2026\*

IN RE: ALTERNATE ASSIGNMENTS

---

To promote the efficient administration of justice, judges are designated as "alternates" to preside over emergency matters when the paired judge is away from the courthouse.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, pursuant to the authority conferred by Florida Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.215, **effective May 4, 2026**, it is **ORDERED**, as follows:

1. Alternates shall coordinate with one another to ensure that one of them will be in the courthouse during normal court hours.
2. If alternates are both scheduled to be absent from the courthouse for periods of vacation, etc., then it shall be the responsibility of each judge to procure emergency coverage for his or her division by another judge.
3. If for any reason alternate judges do not carry out this responsibility, then the duty judge shall preside over emergency matters in such divisions.

<sup>1</sup> Judge Moses Stephens is the only County Judge located at the North County Courthouse. As such, the Circuit Judges located there must assist as her alternate.

<sup>2</sup> Judge Alijewicz is the only Judge located at the Belle Glade Complex. Alternate assignments for Judge Alijewicz are as follows: a) for all Juvenile matters coverage by Division JM; b) for Division FW Injunctions (all case types) coverage by Division DVTD; c) for Division FW Domestic Relations (Family) coverage by the signing week North County Family Judge; d) for Division RA (County Civil) coverage by Gun Club County Court Judge; e) for Division IW coverage by the administrative magistrate (see, AO 6.101C.3 and AO 6.107 D.3); f) Circuit Court (felony matters) coverage by the Gun Club Circuit Court Judge.

<sup>3</sup> DOR Magistrates Bruno and J. Williams cannot serve alternates to other family division Magistrates due to Federal funding. However all other Magistrates in the Main Courthouse shall serve as the alternate to DOR.
